Subject: Tempcast 2000 masonry fireplace.

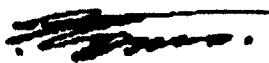
Dear Sir,

While the 2000 masonry fireplace may be considered as downdraft type it should not prevent adequate venting since the height of the chimney or vent more than compensates for the initial downflow.

Therefore if the design of the fireplace is in accordance with the ASTM E 1602-94 document there is no reason why it should not function quite safely as confirmed by the OMNI Environmental Services Report dated May 8, 1992.

If the fireplace is built and installed correctly in accordance with your design and instructions it can be expected to operate safely without creating any undue hazard.
