Guys,

The following motion has been arrived at by a sub-committee (Marty, Chris, myself, Dick) of the Education Committee to look at a more flexible way for certified builders to maintain their certification. The number of CEU's has been raised for giving and attending workshops: we're proposing giving CEU's for holding an elected office or chairing a committee, and to give our out-of-country builders an avenue, we've added the ability to submit a documented photo sequence of a hand build. We also added "or the equivalent" for some of the requirements, to give us flexibility in determining how many, if any, CEU's to award educational experiences that fall outside the parameters of a typical seminar or workshop. The focus of the motion is to address concerns that there be more/other opportunities for maintaining certification than the time and expense involved in coming to the AGM.

-An Instructor Profile and Course Description (IPCD) form must be completed and submitted to the MHA office. Form will be reviewed by education committee chairman, or designate thereof.

-If a submitted IPCD is deemed acceptable, instructor will be notified and MHA will help promote the workshop. Example: calendar of events, MHA website, Newsletters, etc.

-If submitted IPCD is deemed acceptable, instructor will earn up to 8 C.E.U. credits and participant will earn up to 6 C.E.U. credits (depending upon length of course and content).

-If submitted IPCD is deemed acceptable, instructor will pay MHA a total of \$100 for sponsorship.
